All questions lead to Film Titles. As an example; the following are all clues to "Black Rain" ...

		FAIRLY LITERAL CLUE TO THE TITLE
a	1990s	Downpour at night
		FAIRLY LITERAL CLUE TO SOMETHING THAT SOUNDS LIKE THE TITLE
b	1980s	Gloomy rule (REIGN sounds like RAIN)
		CLUE TO CONTENT OF FILM
c	1980s	NYC meet Yazuka
		MORE OBTUSE CLUE TO TITLE
d	1980s	Opposite of white sunshine
e	1980s	Sounds like you might need this to make black ice
		ANAGRAM
f	1980s	Lack brain (being the exact letters in BLACK RAIN)

These examples are to demonstrate the sorts of clues you might expect. But the majority of them will fall into that most difficult to define category of "More Obtuse Clue to Title". The aim is for them to be obtuse (not cryptic); but despite this, it is to a certain extent "anything goes" here.
