All questions are anagrams of Novel Titles. As an example; the following are both clues to "Amsterdam" ...

All of the novels will be fairly well known; and will be titles that are still actively read today. The date shown is that of first publication. Only the actual letters are counted - for example, the novel "Midnight's Children" would be shown as (9,8); and the novel "The Sea, the Sea" would be shown as (3,3,3,3)
