



The clues are normal (non-cryptic) although some are a bit obtuse. The "entered" answer (in the grid) must be an anagram of the "original" answer.

For example, if there was a clue ...  
7 - Flightless bird (4)

The "original" answer could be RHEA. So, the "entered" answer would be either HARE or HEAR.

If there is a reference to another clue, it will refer to the "entered" answer (ie what is in the grid).

There can be proper names for "original" but not "entered" answers. Thus, HERA (goddess) could be "original" but not "entered".

*There are 16 highlighted squares. Form an anagram from these to make an example of 2-down (ie the "entered" answer there).*
